Dear ones,

This Sunday, our service in celebration of Easter opens with Artist in Residence Rodger Clinton Vine on organ playing Bach's *Awake, Thou Wintry Earth*. Then our ministers and choir will process down the center aisle to the first of our Easter hymns, *Lo, the Day of Days is here!*

The musical centerpiece of the service, conducted by Director of Music Mark David Buckles, is David Conte's *Invocation and Dance*, with words based on Walt Whitman's *When Lilacs Last in the Dooryard Bloom'd*. The Arlington Street Choir will be accompanied by xylophone, vibraphone, glockenspiel, and four-hand piano: Hyunju Jung and Yulia Yun will sit next to each other on the piano bench, playing at the same time; there may be fireworks!

Tenor Daniel Rosensweig brings us *If I Sing* (from *Closer than Ever*) and Bek Zehr, Mark David, and Sé Brown sing Brandi Carlisle's *This Time Tomorrow*. My sermon is called *What Do We Have Left?* To close, we'll all sing the same tune but you can choose your words, depending on your theology: either *Lo, the Earth Awakes Again* or *Jesus Christ is Ris'n Today!* I'll go with this:

Change, then, mourning into praise
And, for dirges, anthems raise
How our spirits soar and sing
How our hearts leap with the spring! Alleluia!

Happy Easter, beloveds!

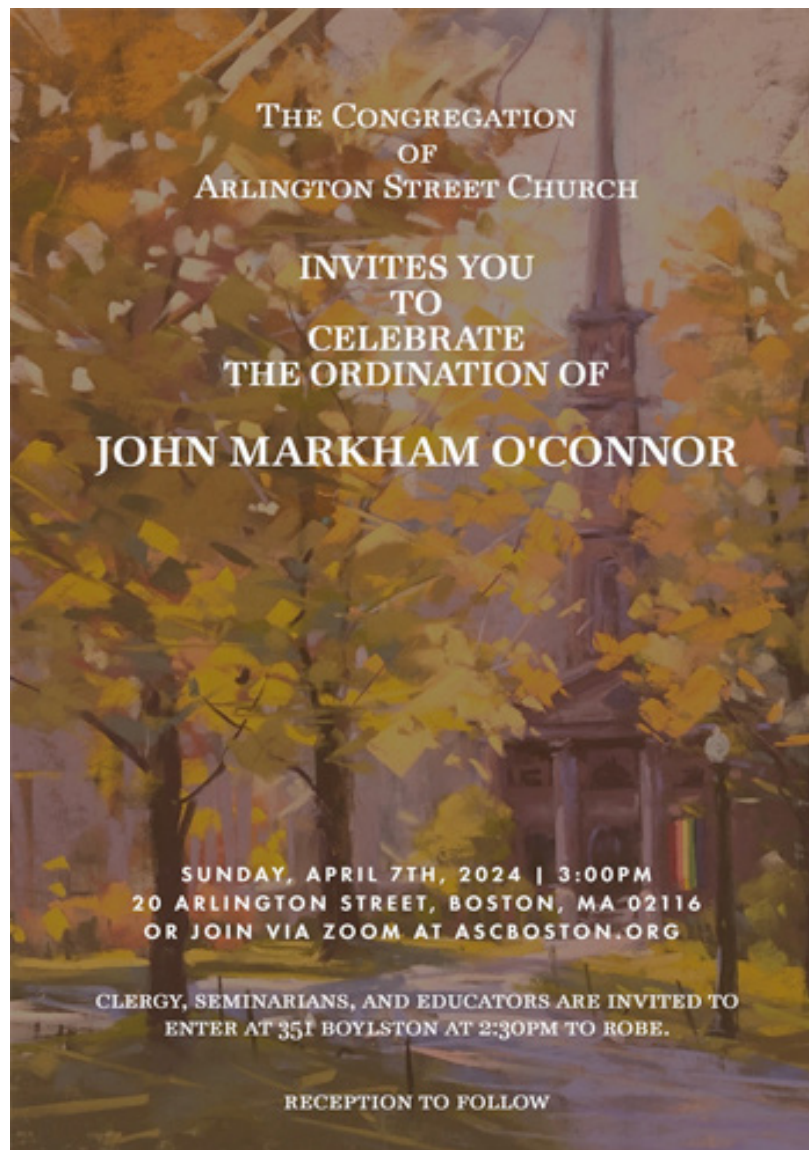

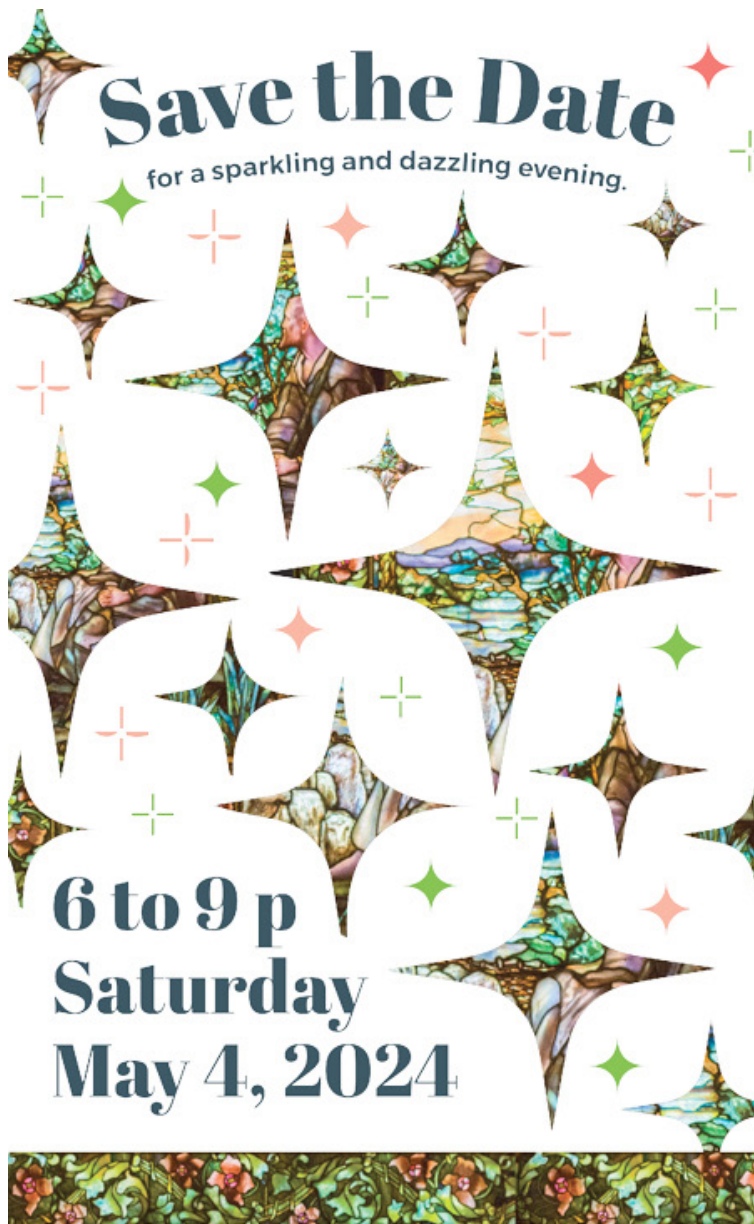
A Message from the Interim Minister Search Committee
