

- Art Nava presented the treasurer's report and a draft FY18 budget, which was approved by the Pru.
- Jennifer Pinck and Brigid Williams presented a preliminary redesign for our new accessibility ramp. Further designs, schedule, and budget will be discussed at next month's Pru meeting.
